

# Pottsgrove School District Transportation Fact Sheet

## A. Major Players

- Pottsgrove School District
  - Ultimately responsible
  - Own buses
- CMD Transportation Services, Inc.
  - Primary contractor
  - Responsible for drivers, routes and fleet maintenance
- Montgomery County Intermediate Unit
  - Contractor for certain special education runs
- Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
  - Regulates pupil transportation
  - Subsidizes the system

## B. Pottsgrove's Transportation System

- Approximate student population – 3,300
- Pottsgrove School District is approximately 16.6 square miles
- 722,000 miles transported by District owned vehicles
- 189,000 miles transported by CMD owned vehicles
- CMD employs 57 drivers and 8 aides devoted to Pottsgrove SD
- Vehicle Inventory
  - 33 – 72 passenger school buses
  - 4 – Wheelchair equipped vans
  - 2 – 24 passenger vans
  - 6 – 16 passenger vans
  - 8 – 9 passenger vans
- Bus Runs
  - Pottsgrove High School – 23
  - Pottsgrove Middle School – 20
  - Elementary Schools
    - Lower Pottsgrove – 13
    - Ringing Rocks - 7
    - West Pottsgrove – 5
  - Non-public schools - 7
  - Special Education – quantity varies
- Pottsgrove's Hazardous Roads
  - Buchert Road
  - Mervine Street – Juniper to Hanover
  - Hanover Road – Mervine to Mauger's Mill
  - Route 422
  - Charlotte Street – Mervine to Bliem Road
  - Pleasantview Road
  - Kiem Street
  - Kauffman Road

- Transportation Costs FYE 6/30/10
  - Total Costs - \$2,375,000
  - Less: Transportation Subsidy - \$925,000
  - Net Cost - \$1,450,000
