Pottsgrove School District School Board awards bids for the Ringing Rocks Building Renovation Project

At a special board meeting of the Pottsgrove School District held on July 20, 2010 the board awarded bids to the low bidders for the Ringing Rocks Building Renovation Project. The board is pleased to announce that the bids came in approximately 10.5% below the construction estimate of \$14,500,000, saving the district approximately 1.5 million dollars. The board also voted to reject the addition of four classrooms at the west side of the building, saving the district an additional \$515,000. Current economic conditions as well as updated enrollment projections impacted the decision to not build these classrooms at this time.

The bid for General Construction Services was awarded to E.R. Stuebner in the amount of \$6,524,000.

The bid for Plumbing Services was awarded to Vision Mechanical, Inc., in the amount of \$742,200.

The bid for HVAC Services was awarded to Landmark Services Company, LLC, in the amount of \$2,841,033.

The bid for Electrical Services was awarded to MJF Electrical Contracting, Inc., in the amount of \$2,024,700.

The bid for Fire Protection Services was awarded to TMI Commercial, in the amount of \$141,300.

Additionally, District Administration has finalized the lease with the Archdiocese of Philadelphia for use of the St. Pius X property. This facility will be home to the Ringing Rocks Elementary School community during the construction period.
