Hello,

I'm writing to update you on our School Board's decisions regarding possible renovations to our school district facilities. At our meeting last Tuesday (April 14) the Board agreed it wants to move forward on a renovation and expansion to Ringing Rocks Elementary School that will cost approximately \$16 million.

Previously, the Board had also examined a broader renovation plan that would include an expansion to the high school as well as improvements to athletic fields. As you may be aware, Ringing Rocks is our school most in need of repair and expansion to bring it in line with our other elementary schools. The Board has not taken a formal vote yet on the Ringing Rocks plan but expects to do so in the near future. The proposed renovation and expansion will add additional classrooms and a new cafeteria to Ringing Rocks. It also includes plan to improve parent and school bus drop-off and pick-up procedures.
