

Elementary Redistricting Committee Summary

December 2, 2011

With the pending completion of the renovation and expansion of Ringing Rocks Elementary School, the Pottsgrove School Board convened an Elementary Redistricting Committee composed of school board members, administrators, teachers and parents.

The charge of the committee is to:

- Review current and projected enrollment trends as well as classroom space available in each elementary school
- Consider the various elementary grade configurations that could work with our enrollment numbers and available physical space
- Review the pros / cons of various configurations to best support our educational programs
- Present our findings to the Board of School Directors along with recommended attendance boundary adjustments needed for each configuration

The Elementary Redistricting Committee met four times during October and November 2011. Meeting summaries, tables of pros and cons for the two school configuration options under consideration, a chart containing elementary class size information for both options, and a list of committee members are available on the District Website at www.pgisd.org.

These findings will be presented to the school board at the December 6, 2011 school board meeting with follow-up discussion at the January 10, 2012 school board meeting. The board will be asked to make a final decision at the January 24, 2012 school board meeting.
