



## Did you know . . .

Families, youth, teachers and community members have access to some great resources in Montgomery County to help address substance abuse concerns:

Adolescents showing signs of early substance abuse are eligible for *Teen Intervene*, a three session Evidence Based Program offered in schools and Prevention agencies. The school districts who participate in this program are: Hatboro Horsham, Norristown, Perkiomen Valley, Pottsgrove, Souderton, Spring Ford, Upper Dublin, Upper Merion, Upper Moreland, Upper Perkiomen, Wissahickon, Lansdale Catholic and Pope John Paul II.

Prevention/Intervention Agencies are also able to provide this service for Montgomery County residents at these offices: Aldersgate Youth Service Bureau (Willow Grove): 215-657-4545, Carson Valley Children's Aid (Norristown): 610-279-2755 and Spring Ford Counseling Services (Royersford): 610-948-0393. This intervention is funded through the Montgomery County Office of Drug and Alcohol at no additional cost to the student.

*Student Assistance Program* (SAP) screening services are also available in the school districts listed above. A screening may be requested through the SAP team, counselor, teacher, administrator or parent/guardian. Once a student is identified as requiring additional resources that are outside of the school's services, that student is then recommended for a complete assessment. Assessments are conducted at these Case Management Offices: Abington Case Management (Willow Grove): 215-830-8966, Creative Health Services (Pottstown): 610-327-1503 and Gaudenzia (Norristown) 610-279-4262. Please note that anyone seeking treatment or has questions regarding treatment - adult or adolescent - may also contact these offices.
