

ELECTRONIC DEVICES

Procedures for Cell Phone/Electronic Devices

The use of cellular phones and any devices that have the capability to take photographs, or record audio or video, or text messaging are prohibited during the school day. Students may transport cellular phones to and from school provided that they adhere to the following requirements:

- The cellular phone must be turned off upon entering any school building and remain off until the student is leaving the school building.
- The cellular phone must be properly stored during school hours within the student's assigned locker or other building assigned location (if no locker is assigned).
- The cellular phone must remain off during a school evacuation.
- The school staff assumes no responsibility for lost and/or damage to personal devices brought to school by students.

Due to privacy concerns, as well as academic integrity issues, the Pottsgrove School District recognizes the need to place strong limitations on the possession and/or use of certain electronic devices. Students found to be in possession of cellular phones, MP3 players, digital cameras, or personal electronic gaming systems during the school day will be subject to disciplinary action.
