SCIENCE LABORATORY SAFETY REGULATIONS

- 1. Adhere strictly to all lab procedures given BEFORE, DURING, & AFTER laboratory activities.**
- 2. Hair MUST be tied back SECURELY.**
- 3. Clear work areas of ALL unnecessary items (i.e. binders, handbags, textbooks, extraneous paper, etc.).**
- 4. Loose clothing, baggy sleeves, & coats may NOT be worn in the lab.**
- 5. Know the location and use of the fire extinguisher, fire blanket, and eye wash.**
- 6. NEVER REACH OVER AN OPEN FLAME.**
- 7. Extinguish flames when any burner is not in direct use (even if you will be using it later).**
- 8. Dispose of experimental materials as directed by the teacher.**
- 9. NEVER taste, eat, or drink anything in the lab.**
- 10. Chemicals that come into contact with the skin need to be washed off immediately with water. NOTIFY THE TEACHER for further safety instructions.**
- 11. Handle sharp dissecting tools with extra care.**
- 12. Wash or sanitize hands before leaving the laboratory.**
