If...	Then...
If your child stops at a word they don't know and looks at you...	Say, "Try it" or "What do you know that can help you?"
If your child misreads a word that doesn't make sense...	Say, "Does that make sense? Check the picture and think about what you read on this page."
If your child misreads a word that makes sense, but the letters don't quite match... (ex: house/home)	Say, "That makes sense, but do the letters match the sounds in the word? Run your finger under the word and try it again."
If your child is not noticing his/her mistakes when reading...	Say, "Are you right? How do you know?" *You can say this even when your child reads it correctly- it trains the brain to always check your reading.
If your child inserts words or omits words...	Say, "Pay attention to the words the author wrote. Read each word."
